The University of Oklahoma Libraries provides students and staff with access to hundreds of electronic databases covering a multitude of disciplines. These databases are a great way to locate scholarly books, journals, government documents, proceedings and more. ABI/INFORM Complete

Database covering business and management topics with information on more than 60,000 companies as well as executive profiles, reports on market conditions, and in-depth case studies of global business trends. Includes Snapshots North America, Oxford Analytical Research (OxResearch), Hoover's Company Records.



Academic Search Elite

Multidisciplinary database covering social sciences, humanities, education, physical and life sciences, and ethnic studies. Over 3,500 journals are indexed.

American History & Culture Online

Sabin Americana contains works about the Americas published throughout the world from 1500 to the early 1900's. Includes books, pamphlets, serials and other documents that provide original accounts of exploration, trade, colonialism, slavery and abolition, the western movement, Native Americans, and military actions.

American Broadsides & Ephemera

Access searchable images of broadsides printed between 1820 and 1900 and ephemera printed between 1760 and 1900. Broadside subjects include contemporary accounts of the Civil War, unusual occurrences, natural disasters, and official government proclamations. Ephemera include clipper ship sailing cards, early trade cards, bill heads, theater and music programs, stock certificates, menus and invitations documenting civic, political and private celebrations.

ABSEES (American Bibliography of Slavic & East European Studies)

Interdisciplinary database covering Slavic and East European studies in the social sciences and humanities. Materials indexed include journal articles, books, book chapters, book reviews, dissertations, online resources, and selected government publications on East-Central Europe and the former Soviet Union published in the United States and Canada.
