Aminda “Mindy” Marques Gonzalez, executive editor and vice president of The Miami Herald, is the first Hispanic woman to become executive editor of a major daily newspaper. She began her journalism career in 1986 as a summer intern in The Herald’s Neighbors community publication. As a reporter, Mindy covered everything from the Hialeah Santeria case that made its way to the U.S. Supreme Court, to the migrant workers in South Dade. As deputy metro editor, she oversaw the city desk, state desk and Neighbors. In 2002, she became Miami bureau chief for People Magazine. She returned to The Herald in 2007 to help oversee the launch of Miami.com and then served as executive features editor and senior editor for news. In October 2010, Ms. Marques became the first Hispanic female executive editor of a major U.S. newspaper.
