Workshops will provide pre-writing and drafting activities for various genres--poetry, essays, personal narratives, descriptions, flash fiction, short stories, and super sentences. Oklahoma Writing Project Teacher Consultants will present all workshops. After lunch, a general session will offer students the chance to write and share with their teachers. All students will leave the conference with a rough draft of a piece they may enter in the 2016 OWP Writing Contest.
