For consideration for the 2016 Health P.A.S.S. Program at Des Moines University, you must complete and submit the following:

- 1 Health P.A.S.S. application
 - Complete the application online at www.dmu.edu/healthpass (available December 1).
- **2** Responses to Health P.A.S.S. application essay questions
- **8** Official transcripts

Please include transcripts from all colleges or universities attended.

- **4** Parents' federal tax returns
 - Submit the 2015 or most recent returns if identifying as economically disadvantaged.
- **5** Letters of recommendation

Include two letters: the first from your science or mathematics professor and the second from any college/university professor with whom you've taken a course.

Return all supporting application materials by March 1 to:

Preference will be given to applicants entering their senior year in the summer of 2016 and demonstrating need in any of the following categories:

- **+ Economically Disadvantaged:** Family income must be within federal low income guidelines. Family tax returns are required to be considered economically disadvantaged. If you are unsure if you qualify, this link from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services may provide some guidance: www.aspe.hhs.gov/poverty/15poverty.cfm
- **+ Educationally Disadvantaged:** Neither parent has completed a bachelor's degree or higher.
- **Underrepresented Minority:** Racial and ethnic populations that are underrepresented in the medical profession relative to their numbers in the general population.
